



Texas A&M Law Hosts Grand Opening for Legal Clinics
Star-Telegram Building Gains New Tenant

Fort Worth, TX, February 11, 2016 – The eight legal clinics that operate through Texas A&M University School of Law have a new home in a 5,200 square foot space within the Star-Telegram building.

Representing more than 70 staff, adjunct faculty and students, these clinics service clients from across the Fort Worth and Dallas area, in matters ranging from family law to intellectual property.

The move follows a chapter of unprecedented growth for the law school, including the addition of more than a dozen new faculty, as well as the doubling of its Admissions and Career Services staffs.

With the expansion of its footprint into downtown Fort Worth, the school can more effectively service clinic clients and also accommodate growth on its main campus.

The school will host a formal grand opening of its clinic space on Friday, Feb. 12 with distinguished guests from the Fort Worth legal community.
