



# TEXAS WATER RECYCLING FACILITIES

## OPERATIONAL AND ONGOING MONITORING STANDARDS

These are not necessarily permits, but rather standards to which the water recycling facility must ensure its compliance throughout its operation.

## FEDERAL CONSIDERATIONS

There are currently no applicable federal standards for the operation of a direct, non-potable water recycling facility in Texas



## STATE CONSIDERATIONS

**Texas Pollution Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Water Permit:** This permit issued by the TCEQ is typically a license for a facility to discharge a specified amount of a pollutant into a receiving water under certain conditions.

**Chapter 210 of the Texas Administrative Code:** The code sets forth requirements related to the transfer, storage, and irrigation using recycled water and design criteria of recycled water systems.

**Texas Land Application Permit (TLAP):** Domestic facilities that dispose of treated effluent by land application (surface irrigation, evaporation, drainfields or subsurface land application) must obtain a TLAP Permit.



## LOCAL CONSIDERATIONS

There are currently no applicable local standards for the operation of a direct, non-potable water recycling facility in Texas.
